Subject: Contract to Cover Professor Riesenfeld's Travel Expenses

The contract pursuant to which we were paying Professor Riesenfeld's travel expenses expired on June 30, 1976. He attended the last meeting in Los Angeles and will be attending future meetings on creditor remedies as the Commission prepares a tentative recommendation relating to enforcement of judgments.

In order to pay his travel expenses for the last meeting and anticipated travel expenses in attending future meetings, the staff requests
that the Commission approve a contract to provide for the payment of
such expenses, the total amount of such expenses to be paid under the
contract not to exceed \$1,000. The contract would contain the standard
provisions for such reimbursement. The term of the contract would be
from February 1, 1977 to June 30, 1979. The Executive Secretary should
be authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the Commission.
