Law Revision Commission Begins Study

The Law Revision Commission has begun a study of “whether the Fish and Game Code and related statutory law should be revised to improve its organization, clarify its meaning, resolve inconsistencies, eliminate unnecessary or obsolete provisions, standardize terminology, clarify program authority and funding sources, and make other minor improvements, without making any significant substantive change to the effect of the law.” The study is being conducted pursuant to ACR 98 (Wagner) (2012 Cal. Stat. res. ch. 108).
