Memorandum 2001-50**Legislative Program: Status of Bills**

Attached to this memorandum is a chart showing the status of bills in the Commission's 2001 legislative program. We will update the chart orally at the meeting. This memorandum provides additional information concerning some of the bills.

AB 223 (Frommer) – Unnecessary Procedural Differences Between Limited and Unlimited Civil Cases

The joint Law Revision Commission and Judicial Council recommendations have been amended into this bill. If any of the joint recommendations proves controversial, it will be amended out and treated separately.

AB 237 (Papan) – Early Disclosure of Valuation Data and Resolution of Issues in Eminent Domain

This bill will next be heard in the Senate Judiciary Committee. Due to workload, the Committee has asked that the hearing be deferred until the Legislature returns from its summer recess in August. The Committee will obtain the necessary rule waivers to authorize the delayed hearing.

AB 873 (Harman) – Estate Planning During Marital Dissolution

The California Land Title Association has suggested it may be useful to clarify the operation of the proposed law on the newly-created form of title, Community Property with Right of Survivorship. The staff is discussing the issues with the State Bar Probate Section and CLTA.

AB 1103 (Papan) – Law Library Board of Trustees

SB 562 (Morrow) – Civil Procedure Technical Corrections

SCR 13 (Morrow) – Resolution of Authority

We have received a copy of a letter from the Consulting Engineers and Land Surveyors of California requesting Senator Morrow to remove from the resolution the authority to study the Subdivision Map Act. They do not believe the Map Act to be overly complex or filled with inconsistencies, and are concerned that the Commission study will become a target of no-growth advocates.
