

## First Supplement to Memorandum 2014-4

### **Trial Court Unification: Publication of Legal Notice (Introduction of Study)**

---

In reviewing Memorandum 2014-4,<sup>1</sup> the staff came across an issue that needs to be corrected. On page 8, the memorandum indicates that there is a statute that currently requires notice through public posting by judicial district. However, that statute was previously amended to remove the reference to “judicial district.”<sup>2</sup> Consequently, that provision is not within the scope of this study.

The public posting statute was not described in Memorandum 2014-4 or included in the Exhibit. All of the statutes described in that memorandum and included in the Exhibit are within the scope of this study.
