

## Memorandum 2018-30

**2018 Legislative Program (Status Report)**

---

The attached table summarizes the current status of the Commission's<sup>1</sup> 2018 legislative program. In short:

- AB 1739 (Chau) (Recordable Transfer on Death Deed: Recordation of FAQ) has been signed by the Governor. Because it is an urgency measure, it has already taken effect.
- AB 2176 (Jones-Sawyer) (Deadly Weapons: Minor Clean-Up Issues) is currently before the Governor.
- SCR 91 (Roth & Chau) (Resolution of Commission Study Authority) has been approved by the Assembly, without amendment. Because it is a concurrent resolution, the Governor's approval is not required. It should be filed with the Secretary of State soon.
