

## MEMORANDUM 2026-3

### Meeting Schedule

---

This memorandum<sup>1</sup> proposes an update to the Commission's 2026 meeting schedule.<sup>2</sup>

At the Commission's December 4, 2025, meeting, the staff proposed two more meetings for 2026 than 2025 because the Commission may be monitoring three bills implementing Commission recommendations as well as its biennial Resolution of Authority, and these additional meetings will allow the Commission to respond if issues arise during the legislative process:

- January 30, 2026
- March 20, 2026
- May 22, 2026
- July 31, 2026
- September 4, 2026
- October 30, 2026
- December 10, 2026

The Commission noted that the proposed meeting on September 4, 2026, falls on the Friday before Labor Day weekend and requested the staff to propose an alternative date.<sup>3</sup>

The staff proposes either that the meeting date be moved to September 11, 2026, or that no meeting be held in September, because the last day of the 2025-26 legislative session is August 31, 2026, and no further Commission decisions on Commission bills would be needed after that date.<sup>4</sup>
