Statutes Made Obsolete by Trial Court Restructuring: Part 8

Request for Public Comment

The California Law Revision Commission has released a tentative recommendation in its ongoing study relating to the extensive restructuring of California's trial court system that occurred slightly more than twenty years ago.

This tentative recommendation focuses on two areas:

- (1) Statutes relating to judicial benefits; and
- (2) Statutes relating to representation and indemnification of trial courts and trial court personnel.

Some of those statutes require revisions to properly reflect the restructuring of the trial court system. The proposed reforms are intended to update the statutes as needed.
